

For a Fruitful Zoom Class Experience:

- Check to see that your speakers and video camera is working in advance.
- If you have any background noise such as children, barking dogs, outside traffic please keep yourself muted.
- Shut off any television or radio.
- If necessary use headphones.
- Please wait to be called on to speak. It is quite difficult to recognize someone else is speaking.
- Everything is Confidential.
- We see what you see. If you are in the dark, you are in the dark for us. Please set yourself up with good lighting.
- Also, get yourself set up in advance so that your face is centered on the screen.
- Webinars are different because of the technology, be patient, it is not difficult but there is a learning curve.

Zoom from a dial-up phone:

- *6 from the phone mutes and unmutes
- *9 from the phone raises and lowers your "onscreen" hand when you wish to share.

There is a Zoom App for Android and iOS. They work with Android phones and tablets and iPhones and iPads.
